

Sacred Wheels and Sigils

Some of the suggested exercises and processes in the *Maximum Purification* program are augmented and supported through the use of power wheels and sigils, that come from the work of mystic and seer, Almine. These are not symbols, but are vibrational portals to infinite treasures of consciousness. What they are more specifically is given below (extracted from the Almine material)¹.

You are asked to keep these in a sacred space, where they will not be carelessly picked up or lost.

Working with Sacred Wheels

A wheel is a visual image that conveys non-cognitive, sacred and empowering information. They are similar to gateways through which specific healing frequencies are drawn and are power sources in the same way a holy object would be. The wheels are alive and as we work with them they provide us with deep insights into the vastness and wealth of our own being, reminding us of all that we are.

Each wheel is a stand-alone wheel and can be used by itself. When wheels are used in a sequence, they tell a story and combine to make an equation.

Mystical practices have a beginning and a closure. If you are working with a sequence of wheels, do not stop in the middle as it leaks resources and energy. For this reason it is important that you always complete each sequence.

To access the information contained within the wheels at a deeper level you may place your hands on the wheels or run your hand across them – the left hand is receptive and the right hand promotes understanding. This technique may also be used for other sacred images, such as sigils and tablets, to access the deeper meaning contained within them.

Lying down, you may also place a wheel at your feet and upon contemplating its meaning, bring it up through your body from your feet to the Lahun Chakra, 10 inches above your head. If a wheel feels ‘stuck’ anywhere, continue to feel the quality of the wheel until it moves freely. If you are working with a sequence of wheels, ensure that the highest numbered wheel is at the bottom and the lowest numbered wheel is at the top. Work with one wheel at a time and fully integrate one before moving on to the next.

Possible Uses for Wheels include:

- Meditate on a wheel.
- Place on the walls of a healing space, office or a room in which you spend a lot of time.
- With intention they can be placed into the body or placed directly on the body.
- Specific wheels can be placed under a healing table when working on someone or under a chair that you frequently sit on.

Sigils

A symbol represents something, whereas a sigil describes something in frequency. A symbol may have a different meaning depending on a person's experience, but a sigil cannot be distorted in any way, because it is the frequency itself. In this regard, a sigil is a power object.

For example, the symbol for the American flag may have a meaning to one person that is vastly different for another. With a sigil, the frequency cannot be distorted in any way, and the person using it is taking in the frequency rather than an interpretation of it.

A sigil is a power of a higher being. It is conferred to a being when a major task within the cosmos has been accomplished. As the being rises in frequency, so too does their associated sigil(s) rise in vibratory power. Angels, gods and goddesses, and highly evolved beings may be invoked through the use of their sigils.

“When a being is called to do a task meant for the highest good, that being will come if you have its name and meaning. The being absolutely must come if, in addition, you have the sigil for the name and meaning. Having someone’s sigil is like having that person’s phone number. Sigils not only describe what they represent, but are a means to communicate with what they represent.”

When you use the sigils in meditation or contemplation from pure intent and for the highest good, the beings will most certainly be present for you. Even if you don't sense their presence, be assured that it is inevitable.
